PhD forsvar: Undersøgelse og måling af den oplevede kvalitet af extern supervision af sundhedspersonalet i Rwandas primære sundhedstjeneste.

I Rwanda behandles mere end 90% af de ikke-indlagte patienter på landets sundhedscentre. Her arbejder ingen læger, kun sygeplejersker hvoraf størstedelen blot har gennemført en begrænset og basal sygeplejeuddannelse. Sundhedspersonalet modtager ekstern supervision, som har til formål både at evaluere sundhedsydelsernes kvalitet og bidrage til sundhedspersonalets faglige udvikling.

I dette projekt har vi undersøgt hvordan sundhedspersonalet og de eksterne supervisorer oplever denne supervision, samt udviklet et spørgeskemaværktøj som personalet kan anvende til at evaluere kvaliteten af deres supervision. Ph.d.-projektet er fra Aarhus Universitet, Health, og er gennemført af Michael Schriver, der forsvare det d. 25/08/2017 kl 12.30.

PhD Defence: Understanding and measuring perceived quality of external supervision of Rwandan primary healthcare providers

More than 90% of all outpatient consultations in the Rwandan healthcare system take place in primary health care centres. No physician work in the health centres, only nurses of which the majority only received a limited and basic nursing education as part of secondary school. These nurses receive external supervision, which aims both at evaluating the quality of care and contributing to the nurses' professional development.

In this project we explored how the primary healthcare providers and the external supervisors experience external supervision, and we developed a questionnaire tool with which providers may evaluate the quality of support in supervision.

The project was carried out by Michael Schriver, who is defending his dissertation on 25/08/2017.
