PhD forsvar

Læge, ph.d.-studerende Anne Sophie Sølling skal forsvare sin PhD med titlen "Langtidsbehandling af osteoporose" fra Aarhus Universitet, Health. Det overordnede formål med denne ph.d.-afhandling var at undersøge langtidsbehandling af osteoporose med fokus på behandlingsstop af lægemidlerne alendronat og denosumab.

Behandlingsstop med denosumab, er associeret med et hurtigt tab af knoglemineral, hvorfor en pause med denosumab ikke kan tilrådes. I et 2-årigt forskningsprojekt med 61 patienter undersøgte det, om behandling med lægemidlet zoledronsyre kan modvirke dette tab af knoglemineral. Forskningsprojektet viste, at behandling med zoledronsyre efter behandlingsophør med denosumab, ikke fuldstændig kan forhindre et tab af knoglemineral i ryg eller hofte.

Behandlingspause med alendronat kan overvejes efter 5 års behandling, såfremt der ikke har været nye knoglebrud under behandlingen og en knoglemineralskanning (DXA-skanning) viser bedring. I et 2-årigt forskningsprojekt med 142 patienter som stoppede alendronat undersøgte det, om knoglemarkører målt i blodprøver kan forudsige et knogletab efter 1 og 2 år. Projektet fandt ingen sammenhæng mellem ændring i knoglemarkørerne hos den enkelte og ændringen i knoglemasse.

PhD defence

MD, PhD-student Anne Sophie Sølling will defend her PhD dissertation with the title "Long-term management of osteoporosis" from Aarhus University, Health. The overall aim of the PhD dissertation was to investigate long-term management of osteoporosis with a focus on discontinuation of treatment with alendronate and denosumab.

Discontinuing denosumab is associated with a rapid bone loss, why treatment is considered to be lifelong. In a 2-year study including 61 patients it is investigated if treatment with zoledronate could prevent this bone loss. The study finds that treatment with zoledronate after discontinuation of denosumab is not able to completely prevent bone loss at the spine or hip.

It is clinical practice to consider alendronate discontinuation after 5 years in patients without any fractures during treatment and a DXA scan finds improvement. In a 2-year study with 142 patients discontinuing alendronate it is investigated if biochemical bone turnover markers could predict bone loss after 1 and 2 years. The project was not able to identify an algorithm predicting bone loss in the individual patient based on bone turnover markers.
